


So what is a mammal?

Do you know?

An animal is a mammal if...

- as a baby, it drinks milk from its mother;
- it has fur or hair. (The hair can be all over its body or just a little on one part of the body.)



In addition, all mammals...

- breathe air;
- look like their parents as babies (in an approximate sort of way);
- are warm-blooded.

(That means they make their own body heat, so their bodies' temperature always stays about the same.)



And most mammals...

- grow inside their mothers' bodies;
- are born live. (Just a few mammals lay eggs.)
